ECTS INFORMATION AND GRADING SYSTEM	<p>Applicants must be aware that the Schools of Visual Arts grants 30 ECTS points for each semester completed. Attention is drawn to the fact that the 30 ECTS points ARE NOT divided into individual semester activities.</p> <p><b>Grading</b> A – pass F – Fail</p>
LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS	<p>Applicants must have sufficient fluency in English to communicate with professors, assistant professors and fellow students with ease, but there are no formal requirements for specific exam scores.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>Personal accident insurance is required.</p>
ACCOMODATION	<p>The Schools of Visual Arts does not provide campus accommodation.
